The CALRE Plenary Assembly meeting held on 26 November 2021 confirmed also for the year 2022 the Working Group on “Health Inequalities in the European Social Health Systems”, which I have coordinated since 2019.


Set up to enhance the European regional policy experiences in reducing health inequalities, in 2021 the Working Group agreed to focus its activities on the impact of Covid-19 on European social and health systems. A collection of information was thus launched on actions implemented by European Regions to contrast and/or prevent the further worsening of inequalities arising from the pandemic.
