Introduction

In 2020, the CALRE Working group "Health inequalities in European socio-health systems", established in 2019 to compare the health and social policies of European regions, produced a collection of good practices in which enforcement and preventive actions against inequalities have been documented on the basis of 18 questionnaires collected.

In 2021 the Working Group continued the study and exchange of Best Practices, focusing on the impact of Covid-19 on health systems and on the inequalities produced by the pandemic by collecting 10 additional questionnaires.

Also in 2021, the Working Group organized an event held in Palermo on July 9, which allowed members to discuss the economic and social crisis resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic and identify possible tools to respond to these new challenges. The proceedings of the meeting were then collected in a Dossier that was distributed to all CALRE members (IT-EN).

In 2022, the persistence of the health emergency, increasing differences between European health systems, confirmed the need to continue the collection of Good Practices for this year as well. In this regard, as already mentioned, a meeting of the Working group in Milan has been scheduled for 13 May, from which it will then be possible to obtain a document containing guidelines for the development of policies for the reduction of health inequalities. This document will then be submitted for approval by the Plenary Assembly.

The meeting in Milan will also be an opportunity to raise awareness of a significant reality of Lombardy in the health sector.

The conclusions drawn up by the Working Group will be handed over to the European Commissioner for Health Stella Kyriakedes.
